

# Reiki for Animals

- **Maintenance**
- **Release tension**
- **General wellbeing**

The name Reiki (pronounced "ray-key") comes from the Japanese words "Rei" meaning spirit and "Ki" meaning energy. All animals work with energy, on your first meeting with an animal they will have you summed up in seconds as your energy interacts with theirs.

The Therapist acts as a pure channel for energy to pass through to the recipient, REIKI will only work for the greatest and highest of good it cannot be pushed upon the recipient and will go to the levels that need work; Physical, Emotional, Mental or Spiritual.

During a REIKI session animals will often experience a sense of peace and relaxation, as the energy flows to areas of need. REIKI can be hands off or hands on (it is non-invasive and does not include the manipulation of muscle or skeletal) depending on the animal during a session the animal remains in control of the treatment; they will accept energy from a distance or will settle by the Therapists hands. Animals will let the Therapist know when they have had enough by walking away.

## Benefits of Reiki for the animal.

Reiki works on many levels and could help support or ease symptoms of the following:

- Maintenance of health and wellbeing
- Speeding up recovery from physical illness of injury
- Emotional issues such as trauma, neglect, fear or lack of trust, helps to ease anxiety-related issues and could improve confidence.
- Complements both conventional and alternative healing methods
- Calming and reducing stress and hyperactivity in highly strung patients
- Energising and revitalising the old or sick patients
- Pain management
- Providing comfort, pain relief and making the transition more peaceful for dying patients.



## Treatment costs

Home treatments (radius outside 5 miles of Crook; extra cost 45p per mile to be added)

**VET consent required prior to Consultation - please contact for forms.**

### First treatment to include;

(Initial Consultation with form to be filled in and aftercare advice).

Cost £40.00 Equine REIKI  
(Time approximately 1 hour)

Cost £25.00 Small Animal (Dog/Cat)  
(Time approximately 45-60 minutes)

### Follow up treatments;

Cost £30.00 per hour Equine Reiki  
Cost £15.00 per 40 minutes Dog/Cat

### CANCELLATION FEES

If the owner cancels within 12 hours or does not attend the appointment then a 50% fee of the normal price must be paid for.

## IT IS NEVER USED FOR REPLACEMENT OR DIAGNOSIS.

Reiki is not a defined act of veterinary surgery. This means that Reiki is not restricted to veterinary surgeons provided there is no element of diagnosis. Whether a veterinary surgeon or not, anyone offering a complementary therapy must ensure they are adequately trained in its application. In accordance with Section 27 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966 and Chapter 19 of the Supporting Guidance for the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons (RCVS) Code of Professional Conduct for Veterinary Surgeons,

### Reiki Practitioners MUST NOT:-

- a) Make a diagnosis of disease in or injuries to, animals including tests performed on animals for diagnostic purposes.
- b) Give advice based on such a diagnosis
- c) Give any medical or surgical treatment to animals.
- d) Perform surgical operations on animals
